A minimum of seven one-time, non-renewable, \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded annually. These are open to any current graduating senior attending Princeton High School, Princeton seniors graduating from Scarlet Oaks or Princeton's Innovation Academy. The application and rules are included in this packet. Completed applications and supporting information will be due back to the 12th Grade Principal's office no later than **12:30 pm on March 27, 2025.**

We are excited to be able to offer you the chance to further your education so that the world will always have more proud Vikings coming into it.

<u>Princeton Education Foundation Scholarship Rules</u>

Application ID #: _____ 2024/2025

- A minimum of seven, one-time, non-renewable scholarships worth \$1,000 each will be awarded by the PEF annually.
- No applicant may win more than one PEF scholarship.
- Applicants must be graduating high school seniors from Princeton High School, Scarlet Oaks or Princeton's Innovation Academy.
- Applicant must have attended a Princeton School and/or Scarlet Oaks for at least their Junior and Senior years.
- Applicant's grade point average shall be 2.5 to 2.9, unweighted.
- Applicant's attendance average shall meet or exceed the senior class attendance goals as set forth by their appropriate school.
- Applicant's behavior record shall meet or exceed the senior class behavioral goals as set forth by their appropriate school.
- Applicant must show proof of acceptance to an accredited college, university, community college, technical school, trade school, or post-high school training at the time the award is given in May.
- Scholarship money will be paid directly to your school upon receipt/invoice to the Princeton Education Foundation.
- Applicants must complete the requested information as well as write a one-page essay on what the "Princeton Advantage" means to them. The essay should be printed using Princeton essay standards (proper grammar, proper sentence & paragraph structure, and typed in 12-point font). All or some of the winning essays could be posted on social media.
- Applicant should list previous community involvement & volunteerism, including but not limited to projects, groups, clubs, internships, etc. These can be from inside as well as outside the school.
- Application shall include two written letters of recommendation, one of which
 must be from within your school (teacher, principal, coach, etc.). The second
 letter could be from inside or outside of the school (Pastor, community group
 leader, employer, a family friend (over the age of 21), etc.) as long as it's a nonfamily member.
- Winners of a scholarship will be notified in early April. Scholarship winners must attend the Princeton Academic Awards Night 2023, Certificate of Scholarship will be presented. (More details will be given about this special evening as they become available.)
